## Ascension Credit Union Scholarship Award

Ascension Credit Union is pleased to offer a \$1,000 scholarship to its graduating senior members planning on entering a post-secondary institutions this fall.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be evaluated on these categories:

- Scholastic Achievement
- Essay
- Extra Curricular Activities

### DEADLINE

Completed applications and all supporting documents must be received by Ascension Credit Union by the close of business on March 31, 2010.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must meet **both** of the following criteria:
  - Be a primary member of Ascension Credit Union
  - Joined ACU before February 15, 2010
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or equivalent (or current college student) taking at least nine credit hours per semester at an accredited college or university for the 2010-2011 academic year. Applicant may be entering an undergraduate program or an associate's degree program at a community college.
3. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA).
4. ACU employees, directors, committee members and their families are not eligible.

### APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT:

1. An **OFFICIAL** high school transcript containing most current available coursework. Transcripts must be received by ACU directly from the school in a sealed, stamped envelope **BEFORE** the March 31, 2010 deadline.
2. An original copy of the following:
  - a. Completed Ascension Credit Union Scholarship Award application
  - b. Typed, double-spaced essay of 500 words or less on the following topic:

**“What are your savings goals? Where do you go for guidance or information about reaching your savings goals? What does a financial institution need to do / offer to be easy for you to deal with?”**
